CHAPTER 118.

An act authorising the Court of Over and Terminer and Passed Feb. 1, gaol delivery in Baltimore county, to make the assessments therein mentioned.

Sec. 1. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the justices of the court of over and terminer, and gaol delivery for Baltimore county, be and they are hereby authorised and empowered to provide in the county charges to be assessed by them, such compensation as has been usually made, or which they shall consider just and reasonable, to the present or any future sheriff, for keeping a night watch at the gaol of said county, and for the trouble and expence of securing unruly prisoners by ironing them.
