SEC. 1. BE IT ENACTED By the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Potomac company, by their president and directors, their successors or a majority of them, shall be and they are hereby authorised and empowered to use and dispose of the land and water rights, now held by the said company, or which they may hereafter acquire in this state, in the erection of mills or other water works on account of the said company, and may use, sell or dispose of the same when erected, or may lease, sell and convey such land and water rights in such manner and upon such terms as to the said president and directors and their successors or a majority of them may appear most advantageous for the interests of the said company; and shall be authorised and empowered to acquire lands and other property contiguous to the canals and locks on said river, by purchase, compromise or exchange; Provided that said company shall not at any time hold more than one thousand acres of land in this state, and provided that nothing herein contained shall be considered to authorise any act or bargain on the part of the said president and directors which shall in its consequences impede, retard or injure the navigation of the said river, canals or locks.
