AND BE IT ENACTED; That subscription books shall be opened on or before the first day of October next, at Middle Town, at the house of Casper Schnebly, at Frederick Town and at Baltimore, for a capital stock for said company of forty thousand dollars, in sixteen hundred shares, twenty five dollars each, under the direction of the following commission. ers or any one of them to wt: at Middle Town by Henry Stemple, Thomas Marlowe, and John Ringer; at the house of Casper Schnebly, John Brien, Frederick Rhorer and Zachariah Clagitt; at Frederick Town, John M'Pnerson, John Grahame and Thomas Shaw; at Baltimore, Hezekiah Clagitt,
