BEIT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Mary. land, That the president, managers and company, of the Baltimore and Frederick Turnpike Road, be authorised and empowered to extend the said road from Boonsborough to that point on the west bank of the Big Conecocheague which the Cumberland Turnpike Company shall fix on, as the beginning of the said Cumberland Turnpike Road under the same regulations and restrictions, except as is hereinafter provided, and entitled to the same tolls, immunities, privileges and advantages, as they are authorised to take and receive by the act to which this is a supplement ; Provided, a majority of the stockholders of the said company shall agree to an extension of the said road within two years from their next annual meeting, and provided the said extension shall be completed in five years

2.
