Dec Sess. and dispose of tickets in said lottery or lotteries, ; Provided, the said Benjamin Biggs, Joshua Delaplane, John Kinsor, Jacob Biggs, James Cooper and John Fleming, or a majority of them, before they proceed to make sale of any ticket or tickets, in the said lottery or lotteries, shall give and execute a bond to the State of Maryland in the penalty of twenty thousand dellars, conditioned that they will well and truly conduct the drawing of the said lottery or lotteries, and that they will apply the money arising therefrom, within two months after the drawing thereof to the payment of the prizes drawn therein, to the adventurers to whom they shall be due, and the necessary expences incurred in the management thereof.

Bond to be lodged.

2. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the said bond shall be lodged in the clerk's office of Frederick county, to be there recorded, and upon such bond or any office copy thereof, suit or suits may be instituted against the obligors therein, or any of them, or their, or any of their legal representatives for any breach or non-compliance with the condition of the same.
