Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Name changed That the name of Edward Ireland Hollingsworth, of Baltimore county, be and the same is hereby changed and altered unto the name of Edward Ireland.

And be it enacted, That all securities, promises, contracts, All contracts, assurances, deeds, and lawful acts whatsoever, hereafter to be &c. to be valid made or done, by or to the issue of the said Edward Ireland Hollingsworth, shall be of the same force and effect, and equally avail to all intents and purposes, as if the name of Edward Ireland had been the true and proper name of Edward Ireland Hollingsworth

An act for appointing a Printer to the State. Passed Jan. 1. Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Printer ap-That Jonas Green be and he is hereby appointed and constituted pointed.

printer to the state. 2. And be it enacted, That it shall be the duty of the printer His duty. appointed by virtue of this act, to print the laws and votes and proceedings of the general assembly, agreeably to the provisions of the act of 1790, chapter 51, section 3, and in conformity to the 64th resolution passed November session 1811; Provided nevertheless, that for the present year the printer aforesaid shall be allowed twenty days in addition to the time heretofore allowed by law for printing the laws, votes and proceedings, after the same shall be delivered to him by the clerk, any thing in any law to the contrary notwithstanding.

3. And be it enacted, That the printer to the state shall, within To give bond. fifteen days after the close of every annual session of the general assembly, enter into bond to the state of Maryland, in the penalty of twenty-four hundred dollars, with such security as shall be approved by the treasurer of the western shore, which bond shall be lodged with the said treasurer, conditioned that he will, as printer to the state of Maryland, faithfully print the laws on paper of good quality, and the votes and proceedings of the general assemblies of Maryland, in the manner and in the time directed by law; and if the said printer, in case he accepts thereof, shall refuse or neglect to enter bond as aforesaid, such printer shall forfeit and pay the sum of one hundred dollars current money for such refusal or neglect, to be recovered and applied in the same manner as other penalties, and shall moreover forfeit his salary as printer to the state.

And be it enacted, That in case of the death of the printer In case of death appointed by this act, or his refusal or neglect to enter into the governor and bond required by this act, during the recess of the legislature, council to apthe governor and council shall proceed to the appointment point,
