Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Trustee to be That the orphans court of Caroline county be, and they are here- appointed to by authorised and empowered, if they think it will be advantage- sell real estate, ous to the heirs of Daniel Wright, of Lemuel, late of Caroline county, deceased, to appoint a trustee to sell and dispose of all the real estate of the said Daniel Wright, of Lemuel, in Caroline county, at such time, and upon such terms, as shall be prescribed by the said orphans court, and that upon the payment of the whole of the purchase money, the said trustees shall convey the said real estate to the purchaser or purchasers, which conveyance being duly made, shall be sufficient to convey all the right, title, claim and interest, of, in and to the said real estate, which the said Daniel Wright, of Lemuel, had any share in, or right to, at the time of his death, except such part as was otherwise devised or disposed of by the last will and testament of the said Daniel Wright, of Lemuel.
