CHAPTER 172.

Passed Feb 13 An act authorising Sarah Bowen, Administratrix de bonis non, of Benjamin Y. Bowen, to complete the collections of the said Benjamin Y. Bowen.

Timeextended for collection

Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the said Sarah Bowen be and she is hereby authorised and empowered, to collect until the first day of January eighteen hundred and nineteen, all balances due the said Benjamin Y. Bowen as collector of the county taxes for eighteen hundred and thirteen and eighteen hundred and fourteen, in the same manner as he could or might have done within the time limited by law, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.

Before execuaccount.

2. And be it enacted, That it shall be the duty of the said Sarah tion to deliver Bowen before she proceeds to execute or distrain the property of any person or persons for public dues in virtue of this act, to deliver to such person or persons chargeable with the same, at least thirty days previous to levying such execution or distress, an account, written in words at full length, of the public dues demanded of him, her or them, with an affidavit annexed, if required, that she hath not received any part thereof, nor any thing as security or satisfaction for the same, more than credit given, to the best of her knowledge.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That all that part of the third section of an act to reinstate in the county court of Allegany county the proceedings of a case therein mentioned, that provides also, that should the road be located in another or different direction, the said David Lynn shall not be entitled to any damages for either of said roads, be and the same is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 174.

Passed Feb 13 Levy for her support.
