CHAPTER 78.

Passed Jan 31 An act to provide for the removal of Lunatic Paupers from the several Counties of this State to the Maryland Hospital.

Lunatic pauremoved to hospital.

Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That pers may be on the certification of a majority of the board of trustees of the poor of any county of this state, of any person's being a lunatic pauper, the levy court of the county where the case may occur, may in their discretion cause the said lunatic pauper to be removed to the Maryland Hospital as soon thereafter as the nature of the case shall permit.

Levy to defray expenses.

2. And be it enacted, That the levy court of the county where the case may occur, are hereby authorised and directed, to levy such sum of money on the assessable property of said county as will defray the expenses incident to the removal of such lunatic pauper to the Maryland Hospital, and the expenses that may be incurred during his or her stay in said hospital, provided the said expenses do not exceed the sum of one hundred dollars per annum, during his or her stay in said hospital.
