League, by virtue of his marriage with said Elizabeth title to proper-League, had acquired to any property which she now is or may ty annulled. become entitled to, in any way or manner whatever, be and the same is hereby annulled and made void; and that the said Elizabeth League be, and she is hereby declared, capable to have, hold, take, receive, sue for and recover, by compromise, suit or suits in law or equity, all such property, in as full and ample a manner as if she were a feme sole, and had never been married, and to hold, use, and enjoy the same, for her own use and benefit, and the same to dispose of according to her will and pleasure, without the molestation, interference, hindrance or consent, of her said husband, in the same manner she could or might have done were she a feme

CHAPTER 93.

An act to establish a Bank and incorporate a Company, Passed Jan 29 under the name of The Frederick County Bank.
