CHAP. CLVII.

An Act relating to the place of holding Elections in the second Election District Passed Feb 12 1820 in Charles County.

WHEREAS the commissioners appointed by an act of assembly, Preamble entitled, An act to regulate elections, passed at November session seventeen hundred and ninety-nine, did by virtue of that act fix upon a certain house at Allen's Fresh as the place of holding elections in the second election district of Charles county: And whereas it is represented that the said house is now uninhabitable, and in a ruinous state; therefore,

1. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the judges of the second election district in Charles county, be and held in such house they are hereby authorised and directed, to hold in future the elections in said district in such house at the place called Allen's Fresh

CHAP. CLVIII.

An Act to alter the time of the meeting of the General Assembly of this State, Passed Feb 12, 1826 and for other purposes.
