SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the area AREAS herein described is ARE hereby added to the Washington Suburban Sanitary District created by Chapter 122 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1918:

All that area THOSE AREAS in Prince George's County described as follows:

- 1. All that area in the Laurel and Vansville Election Districts and all that area in the Bowie Election District lying northwest of the Baltimore-Washington Parkway not now included within the existing boundary of the Washington Suburban Sanitary District.
- 2. ALL THAT AREA IN THE OXON HILL AND PISCATAWAY ELECTION DISTRICTS WITHIN THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED BOUNDARIES:

BEGINNING FOR THE SAME AT A POINT ON THE EXIST-ING BOUNDARY OF THE WASHINGTON SUBURBAN SANI-TARY DISTRICT, SAID POINT BEING 500 FEET SOUTH OF THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE STEED ROAD AND 500 FEET SOUTHEAST OF THE SOUTHEAST SIDE OF THE ALLEN-TOWN ROAD AND RUNNING THENCE IN A SOUTHWEST-ERLY DIRECTION, SOUTHEAST OF, PARALLEL TO, AND 500 FEET DISTANT FROM THE SOUTHEAST SIDE OF THE AL-LENTOWN ROAD TO A POINT 500 FEET EAST OF THE EAST SIDE OF OLD FORT PLACE, THENCE IN A SOUTHERLY DI-RECTION, EAST OF, PARALLEL TO, AND 500 FEET DISTANT FROM THE EAST SIDE OF OLD FORT PLACE TO A POINT 500 FEET EAST OF THE EAST SIDE OF OLD FORT ROAD, THENCE IN A SOUTHERLY DIRECTION, EAST OF, PAR-ALLEL TO, AND 500 FEET DISTANT FROM THE EAST SIDE OF OLD FORT ROAD TO A POINT AT RIGHT ANGLES TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 5 AS SHOWN ON A PLAT OF SUBDIVISION ENTITLED "FRIENDLY FARMS" RECORDED GEORGE'S AMONG THE LAND RECORDS OF PRINCE COUNTY, MARYLAND IN PLAT BOOK W.W.W. 19 AS PLAT NO. 20, THENCE IN A WESTERLY DIRECTION AT RIGHT ANGLES TO THE OLD FORT ROAD TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 5, "FRIENDLY FARMS", THENCE IN A WESTERLY DIRECTION WITH THE SOUTH LINE OF LOT 5 AND THE REAR LINES OF LOTS 8 THROUGH 24 AS SHOWN ON THE AFORESAID PLAT OF "FRIENDLY FARMS", CLUDE SAME, TO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF LOT 24, "FRIENDLY FARMS", THENCE IN A NORTHWESTERLY DIRECTION ALONG A STRAIGHT LINE DRAWN FROM THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SAID LOT 24 TO A POINT IN THE EXISTING BOUNDARY OF THE WASHINGTON SUBURBAN SANITARY DISTRICT, SAID POINT BEING ON THE PARAL-LEL OF LATITUDE 38° 45′ 00″ NORTH AND 500 FEET EAST OF THE EAST SIDE OF LIVINGSTON ROAD, THENCE IN A GENERALLY NORTHERLY AND SOUTHEASTERLY DIREC-TION WITH THE EXISTING BOUNDARY OF THE WASHING-TON SUBURBAN SANITARY DISTRICT TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That the jurisdiction of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission is hereby extended to include the area AREAS above described and said areas shall be sub-
