CHAPTER 713

(House Bill 874)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 47 (i) of Article 25 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1956 Supplement), title "County Commissioners", sub-title "County Treasurer", and to add new Section 47 (r) to said Article and sub-title (1951 Edition and 1956 Supplement), providing for the compensation of the county treasurer of Talbot County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 47 (i) of Article 25 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1956 Supplement), title "County Commissioners", sub-title "County Treasurer", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, and that a new Section 47 (r) be and it is hereby added to said Article and sub-title (1951 Edition and 1956 Supplement), and all to read as follows:

47. Salary of county treasurers.

(i) Caroline, Queen Anne's [Talbot] and Wicomico counties.—The county treasurers of Caroline, Queen Anne's [Talbot] and Wicomico counties shall each receive an annual salary of \$3,000.00.

(r) *Talbot County.*—*The county treasurer of Talbot County shall receive an annual salary of \$3,500.*

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect January 1, 1959.

CHAPTER 714

(House Bill 876)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 40 (f) and 40 (g-a) of Article 10 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1956 Supplement), title "Attorneys at Law and Attorneys in Fact", sub-title "State's Attorney", providing for the salary and secretarial allowances of the State's Attorney for Talbot County.
