of the fisheries in the Potomae River. The Governor of Maryland, from time to time, shall inform the State Department of Tidewater Fisheries and each of the several Clerks of Court in the State of Maryland as to whether or not there is any such claim being asserted or pending by, from or on behalf of the State of Virginia, or one of its political sub-divisions, or a resident or citizen of the State of Virginia. No license shall be issued under the provisions of this Act during the time any such claim is being asserted or is pending; and any such license which is issued and outstanding, together with the rights and privileges it provides, shall be immediately abrogated and annulled, with no refund of any fee paid therefor, if, during the period for which it was issued, any such claim is asserted or is pending.

SEC. 43. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1957.

CHAPTER 771

(House Bill 389)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 916 and 917 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Prince George's County (Everstine's 1953 Edition, being Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, as enacted by Chapter 80 of the Acts of 1955), title "Prince George's County", sub-title "Jurors", providing for the selection, drawing and summoning of jurors for said county.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 916 and 917 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Prince George's County (Everstine's 1953 Edition, being Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, as enacted by Chapter 80 of the Acts of 1955), title "Prince George's County", sub-title "Jurors", be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

916. In Prince George's County there shall be procured by the Clerk of the Circuit Court of said county a jury box of convenient size. Twhich shall be divided into as many compartments as there may from time to time be election districts in said county, and which compartments shall be numbered to correspond with the election districts of the county as they now exist, or may be increased or decreased from time to time that when WHEN the names of the persons shall have been selected to serve as jurors by the judge or judges of the Court in the manner prescribed in Article 51 of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Jurors", the judge or judges may before the convening of the term of Court to which said jurors are to be sum-
