sub-title "County Commissioners", to follow immediately after Section 84-H thereof, as said Section 84-H was added by Chapters 186 and 226 of the Acts of 1951, relating to appropriations by the County Commissioners of Charles County for tuition of students at a junior college therein.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That new Section 84-I be and it is hereby added to Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Charles County", sub-title "County Commissioners", to follow immediately after Section 84-H thereof, as said Section 84-H was added by Chapters 186 and 226 of the Acts of 1951, and to read as follows:

84-I. The County Commissioners of Charles County be and they are hereby authorized and directed to appropriate a sum of money for the tuition of students at any junior college now or hereafter established in Charles County BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION. Said sum shall be equal to \$200. for each student, up to a maximum of 200 students.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1957.

CHAPTER 831

(House Bill 926)

AN ACT to repeal sub-section 71(b) of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1956 Supplement), title "Alcoholic Beverages", sub-title "Rights and Duties of Licensees", relating to transfers of alcoholic beverage licenses in Allegany County.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That sub-section 71(b) of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1956 Supplement), title "Alcoholic Beverages", sub-title "Rights and Duties of Licensees", be and it is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1957.
