LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE IF WITHIN A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS ANY LICEN-SEE IS CONVICTED TWICE FOR VIOLATING IN OR ON THE LICENSED PREMISES ANY OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE CONCERNING AN ILLEGAL SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON SUNDAY, OR IF WITHIN SAID PERIOD THERE ARE TWO CONVICTIONS OF THE SAME CLERK, AGENT, EMPLOYEE OR SERVANT OF A LICENSEE UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE, FOR ANY VIOLATION IN OR ON THE LICENSED PREMISES CONCERNING ILLEGAL SALES OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON SUNDAY. FURTHER. THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS SHALL REVOKE OR SUSPEND ANY LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE FOR ANY CONVICTION OF THE LICENSEE OF ANY VIOLATION IN OR ON THE LICENSED PREMISES OF ANY OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF MARY-LAND CONCERNING GAMBLING OR GAMING, OR FOR ANY TWO CONVICTIONS OF ONE OR MORE OF THE CLERKS, AGENTS, EMPLOYEES OR SERVANTS OF A LICENSEE UN-DER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE OF VIOLATIONS IN OR ON THE LICENSED PREMISES CONCERNING GAM-BLING OR GAMING, WHICH OFFENSES OCCURRED WITHIN A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS. THE WORD "CONVICTION" AS USED IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO INCLUDE A VERDICT OR PLEA OF GUILTY, OR PLEA OF NOLO CON-TENDERE, OR THE FORFEITURE OF A BOND OR COLLAT-ERAL ACCEPTED ON ANY CHARGE, WARRANT OR INDICT-MENT, BEFORE ANY JUSTICE OF THE PEACE, TRIAL MAGIS-TRATE OR CIRCUIT COURT BEFORE WHICH ANY SUCH CHARGE, WARRANT OR INDICTMENT MAY BE PENDING.

For the purpose of this sub-section two or more violations against the same licensee, agent, servant or employee or affecting the same premises occuring on the same day shall be deemed and considered as one offense, AND FURTHER, THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT SHALL BE APPLICABLE ONLY TO VIOLATIONS AND OFFENSES OCCURRING AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted. That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1957.

CHAPTER 849

(House Bill 829)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 93 of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1956 Supplement),
