SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 145 of Article 25 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "County Commissioners", sub-title "Public Landings", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

145. Upon all applications to establish a public landing, the same proceedings shall be had as on applications to open a public road. Provided that the procedures in this section shall not be applicable in Queen Anne's County.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1957.

CHAPTER 133

(House Bill 379)

(d) (Baltimore [County] and Queen Anne's Counties.)—The Sheriff of Baltimore [County] and Queen Anne's Counties shall be entitled to charge and receive the following fees for the following items in lieu of the fees provided for such items in the above Subsection (a), to wit:
