

nances submitting the whole or any part of this loan to the legal voters of Baltimore City shall provide for the expenditure of the proceeds thereof in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, and by the municipal agency designated in the annual Ordinance of Estimates of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore.

SEC. 5. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1957.

## CHAPTER 241

(House Bill 41)

AN ACT to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to issue the Certificates of Indebtedness of said corporation to an amount not exceeding Seven Million, Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$7,500,000), the proceeds of the same to be used for the purpose of extending, enlarging, developing and improving the Municipal Water Supply and the Water System of Baltimore City, including, but not limited to the construction, reconstruction and extension of transmission conduits, tunnels, and distribution mains, the increasing of the source or sources of supply, the construction of additional storage reservoirs, additions to and extensions of existing reservoirs, the construction of additional pumping stations, filter basins or plants, additions to and extensions of existing pumping stations, filter basins or plants, any or all of the work to be done either within or outside of the boundary lines of Baltimore City, and the doing of all things necessary, proper or expedient to secure a full and adequate supply of water for the City of Baltimore and its inhabitants and such other persons or other legal entities as may now or hereafter be lawfully furnished water by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore; and to authorize said municipality to submit an ordinance or ordinances for said purpose to the legal voters of Baltimore City.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore be and it is hereby authorized to issue the certificates of indebtedness of said corporation to an amount not exceeding Seven Million, Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$7,500,000), said certificates of indebtedness to be issued from time to time and for such amounts, payable at such periods, and to bear such rate or rates of interest, all as the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore shall by ordinance or ordinances from time to time provide; but said certificates of indebtedness shall not be issued, in whole or in part, unless an ordinance or ordinances of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore providing for the issuance
