

shall be borrowed by the sale of bonds that said bonds shall be designated "Public School Bonds of Talbot County", and shall be of such denomination or denominations, callable or non-callable, and of such type, or form, and of such period of maturity as the said County Commissioners of Talbot County may deem advisable, and said bonds shall be signed by the President of said County Commissioners of Talbot County and the Treasurer of said County and have the corporate seal of said Talbot County affixed thereto, and the principal amount of said bonds and the interest payable thereon shall be and remain exempt from taxation by the State of Maryland and by the Counties and Municipalities of said State; provided further that if any such bonds shall be sold, the provisions of Article 31, Sections 33 and 34 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition, as amended from time to time) shall be complied with.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That the proceeds of such notes and/or the proceeds from the sale of such bonds shall be placed in a special fund by the County Treasurer and shall be paid out by him only on warrants from the County Commissioners of Talbot County for such expenditures as it shall deem proper, in the sole discretion of said Board, to purchase land and erect thereon new school buildings, to purchase new equipment for newly constructed school buildings and to pay architectural and other professional fees in connection with such construction.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted*, That for the purpose of paying the interest on said notes and/or bonds and for redeeming said notes and/or bonds as they mature, the County Commissioners of Talbot County shall annually levy such tax upon the assessable property of said County as may be necessary to pay the annual interest on said notes and/or bonds and to redeem said notes and/or bonds as they become due until all of said notes and/or bonds shall have matured and been redeemed. The taxes so levied shall be collected in the same manner as other taxes are levied and collected in said County.

SEC. 4. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1957.

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## CHAPTER 289

(House Bill 595)

AN ACT to repeal Section 219 of Article 18 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Queen Anne's County", sub-title "Court House Square", and to enact a new Section 219 in lieu thereof, to stand in the place and stead of the section so repealed, relating to the use of Court House Square in Centreville, Queen Anne's County.
