

DELIVER A SEALED CONTAINER WITH ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO THE PERSON ORDERING THE SAME. *Any minor having such alcoholic beverages in his possession as aforesaid shall upon conviction be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).*

*The trial magistrate shall have original jurisdiction to hear any violation of this sub-section, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.*

114. (b)-2. *No licensee, proprietor, or operator of any establishment dispensing alcoholic beverages shall permit the consumption or possession of any alcoholic beverages by a person under the age of twenty-one years upon said premises no matter by whom such alcoholic beverages shall have been purchased or from whom obtained. Anyone violating this sub-section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) in addition to any other penalties as provided under this Article.*

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1957.*

#### CHAPTER 434

(Senate Bill 375)

AN ACT to add new Sections 114 (b)-1 and 114 (b)-2 to follow immediately after Section 114 (b) of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1956 Supplement), title "Alcoholic Beverages", sub-title "Restrictions Upon Licenses", providing that it shall be unlawful for any minor in Wicomico County, WITH CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS, to possess alcoholic beverages; providing further that it shall be unlawful for any licensee, proprietor, or operator of an establishment dispensing alcoholic beverages to allow any minor to consume alcoholic beverages upon said premises; and further providing a penalty for violation of these infractions.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That new Sections 114 (b)-1 and 114 (b)-2 be and they are hereby added to Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1956 Supplement), title "Alcoholic Beverages", sub-title "Restrictions Upon Licenses", to follow immediately after Section 114 (b), and to read as follows:*

114. (b)-1. *In Wicomico County, it shall be unlawful for any person under the age of twenty-one years, EXCEPT A BONA FIDE EMPLOYEE IN THE COURSE OF HIS EMPLOYMENT, to possess or have upon his person any alcoholic beverages. Any minor having such alcoholic beverages in his possession as aforesaid shall upon con-*
