

SEC. 4. *And be it further enacted*, That no passenger motor vehicle to be used by a State officer or employee, other than an elected official OR THE COMMISSIONER OF MOTOR VEHICLES, shall be purchased with funds appropriated by this act, the net cost of which inclusive of trade-in-allowance, shall exceed \$2,200.

SEC. 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT CONTINGENT UPON THE ENACTMENT OF SENATE BILL NO. 170 AND SUBJECT ONLY TO THE EXCEPTION THEREIN FOR ACUTE EMERGENCIES, ALL PAYMENTS MADE FOR PERSONAL SERVICES FROM APPROPRIATIONS CONTAINED HEREIN SHALL BE BASED ON STANDARD SALARY SCALES, FACULTY SCALES, FLAT RATE SALARIES, PER DIEM RATES AND AMOUNTS FOR TECHNICAL AND SPECIAL FEES APPROVED AS OF JUNE 30, 1957.
