

STATE OF MARYLAND, TO SAINT LUKE'S METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH OF WOODLAWN NOW KNOWN AS ST. LUKE'S METHODIST CHURCH OF WOODLAWN, DATED MAY 8, 1931, AND RECORDED AMONG THE LAND RECORDS OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, IN LIBER L.McL.M. 880, FOLIO 84, WHICH DEED CONVEYS 3 PARCELS OF LAND:

A. A TRACT OF LAND CONTAINING 46 SQUARE PERCHES OF LAND MORE OR LESS,

B. A TRACT OF LAND CONTAINING AND LAID OUT FOR ½ ACRE OF LAND FRONTING ON GWYNN OAK AVENUE;

C. ALL OF LOT 4 IN THE SOUTHWESTERNMOST 10 FEET OF LOT 3 ON A PLAT RECORDED WITH A DEED FROM M. CLIFTON SMINK AND WIFE TO J. M. RANDOLPH BURK.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1957.

CHAPTER 481

(Senate Bill 462)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 446(f) of the Laws of Harford County (1942 Edition), being Article 13 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Harford County", sub-title "Roads", said section having been last amended by Chapter 120 of the Acts of 1951, relating to the power of the Roads Engineer of Harford County to purchase materials where the amount of such purchase does not exceed ~~\$750.00~~ ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00).

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 446(f) of the Laws of Harford County (1942 Edition), being Article 13 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Harford County", sub-title "Roads", said section having been last amended by Chapter 120 of the Acts of 1951, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

446. (f) The said Roads Engineer shall examine and certify to the correctness of all bills and accounts for work and materials furnished for any of the roads and bridges, or for any other construction or repair work done by the County under his supervision; also all expenditures for or in connection with the purchase, repair, maintenance or operation of any of the aforementioned machinery or equipment; also for all supplies purchased for any of the above mentioned purposes. He shall have the power to purchase materials necessary for the proper performance of his duties where the amount of such purchase does not exceed **Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00)**
