

## CHAPTER 507

(Senate Bill 615)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 40(f) of Article 40 10 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1956 Supplement), title "Attorneys at Law and Attorneys in Fact", sub-title "State's Attorney", increasing the money allowed for clerical expenses for the State's Attorney of St. Mary's County and abolishing the rental allowance.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 40 (f) of Article 40 10 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1956 Supplement), title "Attorneys at Law and Attorneys in Fact", sub-title "State's Attorney", be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments to read as follows:

40.

(f) Charles, St. Mary's and Talbot counties.—The State's attorneys of Charles, St. Mary's and Talbot counties shall each receive an annual salary of \$3,000.

The State's attorney of St. Mary's County shall be allowed [twelve hundred dollars (\$1,200.00)] *eighteen hundred dollars (\$1,800.00)* annually for clerical expenses [and a six hundred dollar (\$600.00) annual rental allowance].

The county commissioners of Charles County are authorized to appoint an assistant State's attorney and a secretary to the State's attorney, each to receive a salary of \$1,800.00 a year.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1957.

## CHAPTER 508

(Senate Bill 626)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 215 (b) of Article 66C of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Natural Resources", sub-title "Birds, Game and Inland Water Fish", sub-heading "Regulations for Taking of Game and Fresh Water Game Fish in Non-Tidal Waters", providing that persons 16 years of age or under need not procure a license to fish in non-tidal waters.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 215 (b) of Article 66C of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Natural Resources", sub-title "Birds,
