CHAPTER 581

(House Bill 411)

AN ACT to add new Section 79A to Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Charles County," sub-title "County Commissioners," to follow immediately after Section 79 thereof, relating to ~~an appropriation~~ APPROPRIATIONS by the county commissioners of Charles County for certain library facilities; AND THE MAINTENANCE THEREOF.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That a new Section 79A be and the same is hereby added to Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Charles County," sub-title "County Commissioners," to follow immediately after Section 79 thereof and to read as follows:*

*79A. The County Commissioners of Charles County are hereby authorized to appropriate the sum of \$20,000 from general funds of the county for library facilities, the same to be located within three miles of the Indian Head, Potomac Heights areas of Charles County.*

79A. THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLES COUNTY ARE HEREBY AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO APPROPRIATE A SUM OF \$20,000 FROM GENERAL FUNDS OF THE COUNTY IN THE YEAR 1957 FOR LIBRARY FACILITIES, THE SAME TO BE LOCATED BETWEEN INDIAN HEAD AND BRYANS ROAD, NEAR STATE ROUTE 210; AND TO APPROPRIATE SUCH SUMS OF MONEY ANNUALLY THEREAFTER AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO MAINTAIN SUCH FACILITIES.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1957.*
