

(i) The term "wild birds" includes all birds other than domestic birds.

(j) The term "wild quadruped" shall mean any quadruped protected or unprotected by law except those species commonly classed as domestic animals.

(k) The term "fur dealer" shall mean a person who buys or otherwise acquires raw and green furs, skins, hides, or pelts of wild quadrupeds from a trapper, or other person, and sells or otherwise disposes of raw and green furs, skins, hides or pelts of wild quadrupeds so bought for resale or transfer or for manufacturing into a finished product.

(l) The term "green pelt" shall mean a pelt which is not dried or cured or tanned.

(m) The word "furs" or "pelts" shall mean and include the raw, green and cured skins, hides, furs or pelts from all wild quadrupeds.

(n) The term "open season" shall mean the time, with the exception of Sunday, during which game and fur-bearing animals may be legally taken or killed and shall include both the first and last day of the season or period designated by this subtitle.

(o) The term "closed season" shall mean the time during which game or fur-bearing animals may not be legally taken or killed and includes all periods of time not included within the open season.

(p) The term "hunt" shall mean to include: Hunt, pursue, catch, kill, trap or shoot, or attempt to hunt, pursue, catch, kill, trap or shoot.

(q) *The term "booby, brush or stake blind" shall mean any off-shore stationary blind, float, raft or boat (except any boat under power, or sink box) that is anchored or tied at a blind site which is legally licensed for the current hunting season.*

#### 151. Methods of hunting; licenses to hunt from boats.

(a) Methods of hunting.—During the open season, wild waterfowl may be taken only with a shotgun which is not larger than ten gauge, which is loaded only with shot and which is fired from the shoulder, *and by the use of the long bow and wood shaft, except that the use of the weapon known as the cross bow is prohibited.* Such wild waterfowl may be taken on land or on water and the aid of a dog or dogs or of *artificial* decoys may be employed. It shall be unlawful to hunt, pursue, or kill any wild waterfowl of any species with or by means of any automatic loading or hand-operated repeating shotgun capable of holding more than three shells, the magazine of which has not been cut off or plugged with a one piece metal or wooden filler incapable of removal through the loading end thereof so as to reduce the capacity of said gun to not more than three shells at any one time in the magazine and chamber combined, unless federal regulations provide otherwise. It shall be unlawful to have a rifle in possession while hunting wild waterfowl. It shall be unlawful to use **[more than ten]** live decoys **[on any property]** at any **[one]** time. No waterfowl, except crippled birds not otherwise retrievable, shall be shot while resting on water or land. It shall be unlawful to use any airplane, sink box or sink boat, or floating device towed by a power boat or a sail boat for the purpose of hunting wild water-
