

Arundel County, if the member so requests, a complete statement of all charges made against such member, and his findings thereon, together with a complete record of the proceedings. Vacancies on said Board for any cause shall be filled by the Governor for the unexpired term, and until a successor shall qualify. Any member of said Board shall be eligible for reappointment, unless otherwise disqualified by the provisions of this section.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1959.

CHAPTER 668

(House Bill 606)

AN ACT to add new Sections 8 (g-1), 9 (g-1), 11 (i-1) and 126A to Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "Alcoholic Beverages", sub-titles "Beer Licenses", and "Restrictions Upon Licensees", to follow immediately after Sections 8 (g), 9 (g), 11 (i) and 126 thereof, relating to fees for beer licenses and to the presence or loitering by minors on alcoholic beverage premises in Kent ~~County~~ AND WICOMICO COUNTIES, and relating generally to alcoholic beverages therein.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That new Sections 8 (g-1), 9 (g-1), 11 (i-1) and 126A be and the same are hereby added to Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "Alcoholic Beverages", sub-titles "Beer Licenses", and "Restrictions Upon Licensees", to follow immediately after Sections 8 (g), 9 (g), 11 (i) and 126 thereof, and to read as follows:

8.

*(g-1) In Kent ~~County~~ AND WICOMICO COUNTIES, the annual license fee for such a license shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00).*

9.

*(g-1) In Kent ~~County~~ AND WICOMICO COUNTIES, the annual license fee for such a license shall be one hundred dollars (\$100.00).*

11.

*(i-1) In Kent ~~County~~ AND WICOMICO COUNTIES, the annual license fee for such a license shall be one hundred dollars (\$100.00).*

*126A. (a) In Kent ~~County~~ AND WICOMICO COUNTIES, it shall be unlawful for any licensee under this Article on whose premises dancing is conducted to allow any minor or minors under the age of twenty-one (21) years to loaf or loiter about the premises for which such license is issued; restaurants may, however, serve meals without alcoholic beverages to minors.*
