## CHAPTER 731

## (House Bill 899)

AN ACT to add a new Section 130(c-1) to Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "Alcoholic Beverages", sub-title "Restrictions Upon Licensees", to follow immediately after Section 130(c) thereof, providing that in Allegany County no manufacturer or wholesaler shall sell any beer to any retail dealer except for cash on delivery and relating to the enforcement of any claim for credit extended in violation of this section.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That a new Section 130(c-1) be and it is hereby added to Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "Alcoholic Beverages", sub-title "Restrictions Upon Licensees", to follow immediately after Section 130(c) thereof, and to read as follows:

130.

(c-1) Sale of Beer for Cash. In Allegany County no manufacturer or wholesaler shall sell any beer to any retail dealer except for cash on delivery. No suit or action ex contractu to enforce or collect any claim for credit extended in violation of this section shall be maintained in this State.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1959.

## CHAPTER 732

## (House Bill 900)
