by-laws are adopted by any one or more of the said volunteer fire companies with respect to the area within which such company or companies will respond to emergency or fire calls within the said Seventh and Eighth Election Districts, then, and in any of said events, the said County Commissioners shall cease to pay any part of the money derived from the special fire tax provided for in this sub-heading to such company or companies so affected.

332T. The Treasurer of each of the said respective volunteer fire companies shall give bond to the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel County in a penal sum to be set by the said County Commissioners, conditioned upon the faithful expenditure of the funds derived hereunder.

SEC. 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT BEFORE THIS ACT SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE IT SHALL FIRST BE SUBMITTED TO THE LEGALLY QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE SEVENTH AND EIGHTH ELECTION DISTRICTS OF ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY AT THE NEXT GENERAL ELEC-TION TO BE HELD IN THIS STATE IN NOVEMBER, 1960. THERE SHALL BE PRINTED ON THE BALLOTS OR BALLOT LABELS, TO BE USED AT SAID ELECTION, THE TITLE OF THIS ACT AND UNDERNEATH SAID TITLE, ON SEPARATE LINES, A SQUARE OR BOX TO THE RIGHT OF AND OPPO-SITE THE WORDS "FOR THE FIRE DISTRICT TAX", AND A CORRESPONDING SQUARE OR BOX TO THE RIGHT OF AND OPPOSITE THE WORDS "AGAINST THE FIRE DISTRICT TAX", SO THAT THE VOTERS OF SAID DISTRICTS SHALL BE ABLE TO DESIGNATE HIS OR HER DECISION FOR OR AGAINST SAID ACT. IF A MAJORITY OF THE VOTES CAST IN THE SAID ELECTION SHALL BE "FOR THE FIRE DIS-TRICT TAX", THEN THIS ACT SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE, BUT IF A MAJORITY OF THE VOTES CAST SHALL BE "AGAINST THE FIRE DISTRICT TAX", THEN THIS ACT SHALL BE OF NO EFFECT AND SHALL BE NULL AND VOID.

SEC. 23. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1959.
