395D. [(a)] The Sheriff of Somerset County shall [be allowed, and the County Commissioners of said County shall be required to pay, the sum of eighty cents (\$.80) per day for boarding and keeping each prisoner committed to his custody, and it shall be the duty of the Sheriff to keep a book at the County Jail in which he shall keep a correct and full statement or schedule of all prisoners committed to his custody showing by what authority, the offense charged, the time when received and the time of discharge, which statement or schedule, together with all books, papers and commitments kept by him pertaining to prisoners in the jail, shall at all times be open to the inspection of the County Commissioners, the State's Attorney and the Grand Jury for said Somerset County, and should the Sheriff neglect or refuse to keep said book or comply with any of the duties which he is hereby required to perform, he shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to indictment, and upon conviction thereof he shall be fined a sum not exceeding one hundred dollars (\$100.00).

**(b)** The Deputy designated as jailer shall be allowed, and the County Commissioners shall be required to pay, the sum of 40 cents for admitting each prisoner to the County Jail, and also the sum of 40 cents for releasing each prisoner from said jail.

395E. The County Commissioners of Somerset County shall furnish all food, fuel and light needed for the County Jail at Princess Anne upon the presentation of itemized statements therefor endorsed by the jailer.

SEC. 4. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1959.

## CHAPTER 795

## (House Bill 734)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 302 of Article 66C of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "Natural Resources", sub-title "Fish and Fisheries", sub-heading "Part 2. Tidal Waters", amending the laws concerning the distribution of certain commercial license fees collected by the Department of Tidewater Fisheries in order to have such fees credited into a Special Fund under the control of the Department of Research and Education; and relating generally to the use and distribution of such commercial license fees.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 302 of Article 66C of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "Natural Resources", sub-title "Fish and Fish-
