I, BLANCHARD RANDALL, SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, DO certify from a certified copy of the election returns from the Town of Oakland, Garrett County Maryland, that an election was held in the town of Oakland on March 8, 1937, for the purpose of voting for or against Chapter 3 of the Acts of 1937 and 394 votes were cast in favor of the adoption of Chapter 3 of the Acts of 1937 and 187 votes were cast against the adoption of the said Act, therefore a majority of the votes being cast in favor of Chapter 3 of the Acts of 1937 it has, therefore, been ratified by the voters of Oakland, Garrett County, Maryland.
