SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1959.

CHAPTER 420

(Senate Bill 532)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 84 to 90, inclusive, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Harford County (1957 Edition, being Article 13 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Harford County", sub-title "Assessments", sub-heading "Board of Assessments", relating to the Board of Assessments of Harford County, said sections now being obsolete.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 84 to 90, inclusive, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Harford County (1957 Edition, being Article 13 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Harford County", sub-title "Assessments", sub-heading "Board of Assessments", be and the same are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1959.

CHAPTER 421

(Senate Bill 540)

AN ACT to authorize and empower the County Commissioners for Kent County, from time to time, to borrow not exceeding Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) in order to finance the construction, acquisition, improvement or extension of public schools in said County, as herein defined, and to effect such borrowing by the issuance and sale to the highest bidder or bidders at public
