

struction costs over \$1,000.00 but less than \$10,000.00; a fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) for construction costs over \$10,000.00. It shall be unlawful to engage in construction without said permit and to knowingly underestimate construction costs in an application for said permit. Any person violating the provisions of this sub-section shall be fined not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and may be enjoined from continuation of the construction until a permit is secured.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1959.

CHAPTER 439

(Senate Bill 287)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 15 (d) of Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1958 Supplement), title "Revenue and Taxes", sub-title "Method of Assessment", relating to the assessment of stock in business in ~~Charles County~~ AND DORCHESTER COUNTIES.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 15 (d) of Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1958 Supplement), title "Revenue and Taxes", sub-title "Method of Assessment", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

15.

(d) Other enumerated counties and City of Annapolis.—For the purpose of county taxation in Allegany, Anne Arundel, Baltimore, Calvert, Caroline, Carroll, Cecil, *Charles*, DORCHESTER, Frederick, Garrett, Harford, Howard, Kent, Montgomery, Prince George's, Queen Anne's, Somerset, Talbot, Wicomico and Worcester counties and the City of Annapolis, such stock in business shall be assessed at sixty per centum (60%) of such fair average value for the twelve months preceding the date of finality.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1959.
