

to follow immediately after Section 9 (45) thereof, exempting from ~~state~~, county and local assessment and taxation for a period of ~~twenty~~ TEN years the real ~~and personal~~ property of any manufacturer, employing more than seventy-five people, who locates in St. Mary's County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That new Section 9 (46) be and it is hereby added to Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition and 1958 Supplement), title "Revenue and Taxes", sub-title "What Shall Be Taxed and Where", to follow immediately after Section 9 (45) thereof, and to read as follows:

9.

(46) *The real ~~and personal~~ property of any manufacturer employing more than seventy-five people who locates in St. Mary's County after the effective date of this act.* SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM COUNTY AND LOCAL ASSESSMENT AND TAXATION. *But such exemption shall last only for a period of ~~twenty~~ TEN years.*

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1959.

## CHAPTER 563

(Senate Bill 519)

AN ACT to add new Section 6 to Article 24 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Worcester County", to immediately precede Section 7 thereof and to be under the new sub-title "Beaches—Removal of Sand", Section 6 having been repealed by Chapter 52 of the Acts of 1945, to prohibit the removal or taking away of A QUANTITY OF sand WEIGHING MORE THAN FIVE POUNDS from beaches along the Atlantic Ocean in Worcester County, and to provide penalties for violations.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That new Section 6 be and it is hereby added to Article 24 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Worcester County", to immediately precede Section 7 thereof and to be under the new sub-title "Beaches—Removal of Sand", Section 6 having been repealed by Chapter 52 of the Acts of 1945, and to read as follows:

### *Beaches—Removal of Sand*

6. *It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to remove, or otherwise take away, any* QUANTITY OF sand WEIGH-
