## CHAPTER 579

## (Senate Bill 607)

AN ACT to authorize the Board of County Commissioners of Frederick County to provide for the publication of a 1959 edition of the Code of Public Local Laws of Frederick County, being Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, and in the discretion of the County Commissioners, of certain ordinances and/or resolutions of the County Commissioners, relating to the provisions for such publication and providing that the Code if published shall be evidence of certain laws.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Board of County Commissioners of Frederick County is authorized to provide for the publication of a 1959 edition of the Code of Public Local Laws of Frederick County, being Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland. The Board is authorized to make the necessary appropriations to defray the costs of publication and it further is authorized to provide for the sale and distribution of the Code.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That if the said Code is published, it is hereby legalized. It shall contain all Public Local Laws relating to Frederick County in effect after the 1959 regular session of the General Assembly of Maryland, and it shall contain the charters of the several municipal corporations within Frederick County as in effect on June 1, 1959. In the discretion of the County Commissioners it may also contain a code of the ordinances and/or resolutions of the County Commissioners. The Code shall be deemed and taken in all the courts of this State and by all Justices of the Peace and Trial Magistrates of the State and by all other public officials
