wheat and other produce to Lawrence and Dorfey's mills, lately erected on the CHAP. western fork of Patapsco falls, and have prayed that a road may be laid out and opened, not exceeding thirty-three feet wide, from the main or turnpike road leading from Liberty-town to Baltimore-town, beginning for the same at or near Benjamin Bennett's, through a part of Baltimore and Frederick counties, to the faid mills; and this general affembly thinking the prayer of the faid petitioners reasonable,

II. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Joshua Porter Commissionand John Evans, of Job, of Baltimore county, and Richard Simpson, junior, of ers appointed, Frederick county, or any two of them, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to survey, lay out and open, at the expence of the said petitioners, a road, not exceeding thirty-three feet wide, in such direction as the situation of the ground will admit, and best answer the purposes of this act, from the said main or turnpike road, at or near Benjamin Bennett's, through a part of Baltimore and Frederick counties to the said Lawrence and Dorsey's mills; and the said road, when so surveyed, laid out and opened, and the valuation herein after directed to be made shall have taken place, shall be recorded in Baltimore county court, and shall be deemed and taken to be a public road for ever thereafter, and kept up, amended and repaired, as all other public roads in the faid counties.

III. and be it enacted, That the said commissioners shall ascertain and value Who shall aswhat damages may be fustained by any person or persons through whose land the mages, &c. faid road shall pais, and the same, when so affessed, shall be paid, or secured to be paid, by the faid petitioners, before the faid commissioners shall proceed to open the faid road: Provided always, that if any person or persons, through whose land the faid road shall pass, or his, her or their guardian or trustee, shall conceive themselves aggrieved by such valuation and assessment of damages by the faid commissioners, it shall and may be lawful for the said commissioners, or any two of them, to issue their warrant to any constable of the county, to summon five fresholders of the county, not interested in the premises, and qualified to ferve as jurors in the county court, to appear on a day by them to be appointed, on the premises; and the said commissioners are hereby authorised to administer an oath to every person so summoned, that he will, without favour, affection, prejudice or partiality, affess the damages sustained by the persons at whose request fuch inquisition shall be taken, by reason of opening the aforesaid road through his, her, or their land; and the persons so summoned and sworn shall thereupon proceed to affels and value the damages accordingly, of which the faid petitioners, or some one of them, shall have at least five days previous notice; and such inquisition shall be final and conclusive between the parties.

IV. And be it enacted, That the said commissioners shall not lay out or open Road not to the faid road through the buildings, gardens or orchards, of any person, without gothro'buildings, &c. his or her confent.

V. And be it further enacted, That nothing in this act contained shall be con- Nor thro' any strued to empower the commissioners aforesaid to lay out the said road through meadow, &c. any meadow in Frederick county without the confent of the owner or owners of faid meadow.

H A P. XIV. An ACT to enable the inhabitants of Saint-John's parish, lying Passed Dein Queen-Anne's and Caroline counties, to elect vestrymen and churchwardens for faid parish.

HEREAS the inhabitants of Saint-John's parish, lying in Queen-Preamble. Anne's and Caroline counties, neglected to meet and choose vestrymen and churchwardens for the said parish, agreeably to the act for the establishment of select vestries;

II. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the inhabitants Inhabitants to meet, &c. of faid parish be and they are hereby empowered to meet at their parish church,
