An ACT to authorise and empower the associate justices of Caro-Passed December 26. line county court to call a court before the time to which the

THEREAS the sheriff of Caroline county lately elected, commission- Preamble. ed and qualified, is dead, and the person second upon the return to the governor and council has refused to act, and the governor, with the consent and advice of the council, hath appointed and commissioned Dekar Thompson sheriff of the said county, to act for the remaining part of the three years for which the aforesaid sheriffs elect were to have acted; therefore,

II. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the associate Justices to call justices of Caroline county court be and they are hereby authorised and empower- a court, &c. ed to call a court before the day to which the same stands adjourned, and when fo called, to proceed to qualify the faid Dekar Thompson as sheriff of Caroline county aforesaid, by administering to him the several oaths, and taking his bond with security, agreeably to the constitution and laws of this state, and the proceedings of the faid justices shall be valid to all intents and purposes, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.

C H A P. IX.

An ACT for the establishment of a market for the sale of live Passed December 26.

flock at Westminster-town, in Frederick county.

THEREAS great convenience and advantage would arise to the citizens Preamble. of this state if a public market was established, under proper regulations, in or near to Westminster-town, for vending live stock of different kinds; and this general affembly being defirous of promoting such an establishment,

II. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Joshua Gist, Commission-Stephen Winchester, David Shriver, senior, David Fisher, Jacob Sherman, John ers appointed, Yingling, Ludwick Wampler and David Shriver, junior, or a majority of them, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners, with full power and authority in them vested to purchase, in fee-simple or for a term of years, a quantity of land, not exceeding three acres, in or near to Westminster-town, and the same land to lay out into small and convenient lots, with proper enclosures and stalls for the reception of cattle, and to hold a market thereon as hereafter provided, which faid land, when obtained, shall be held by the commissioners aforesaid, and their fuccessors, in trust, for the purposes in this act contained.

III. And be it enacted, That from and after the first day of March next, one Market-day day in every week, to wit, Thursday, shall be held as a market-day at the said established. market-space, and the commissioners aforesaid may moreover establish as marketdays two or more days in each year, for holding a general market in the faid market-space, and all horses, sheep, hogs, and live cattle of every kind, that may be brought to the faid town, and that may be for fale, on any of the faid market-days, shall be carried to the said market-space to be sold.

IV. And be it enacted, That no person shall buy or sell, or cause to be bought No person to or fold, from or to any person or persons within three miles of the said town of buy out of Westminster, any horse, live cattle of any kind, sheep or hogs, driving to market upon market-days, at any place whatfoever but at or in the faid market-space, under the penalty of three dollars for every such offence, to be recovered from fuch purchaser or seller, severally, for the use and in the name of the informer, before a fingle magistrate, as small debts are by law directed to be recovered.

V. And be it enacted, That on the death, removal from Frederick county, or How vacanrefignation, of any of the said commissioners, the major part of the remaining siled. commissioners shall appoint another to serve in the stead of such commissioner so dying, removing or refigning. VI. And
