Dear Mr. Speaker:

I have today vetoed House Bill No. 742 and in accordance with the provisions of Article 2, Section 17 of the State Constitution, I am returning this bill to you along with my veto message.

House Bill No. 742 was designed to create a State debt in the amount of \$8,000,000, the money to be used by the Maryland Port Authority for the expansion of its facilities. This particular bill is an exact duplicate of Senate Bill No. 478, which was signed by me on April 24, 1961.

Because the Senate Bill has already been signed, I deem it unnecessary to place my signature on House Bill No. 742.
