

## CHAPTER 4

(Senate Bill 9)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 47 (a) of Article 26 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "Courts", sub-title "Salaries of Judges", providing for increases in the salaries of the Chief Judge and of the associate judges of the Court of Appeals of Maryland.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 47 (a) of Article 26 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "Courts", sub-title "Salaries of Judges", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

47 (a). The salary of the Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals shall be [twenty-two thousand dollars (\$22,000)] *twenty-five thousand five hundred dollars (\$25,500)* per annum; the salary of each of the associate judges of the Court of Appeals shall be [twenty-one thousand dollars (\$21,000)] *twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000)* per annum.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1962.

## CHAPTER 5

(Senate Bill 10)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, sub-sections (b) and (c) of Section 47 of Article 26 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "Courts", sub-title "Salaries of Judges", increasing the salaries of the judges of the first seven Judicial Circuits of this State and of the Supreme Bench of Baltimore City and declaring that nothing herein shall be construed to modify or affect in any manner the provisions of Section 2 of Chapter 889 of the Acts of 1945 or the provisions of Section 4 of Chapter 81 of the Acts of 1949.

Section 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That sub-sections (b) and (c) of Section 47 of Article 26 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title "Courts", sub-title "Salaries of Judges", be and they are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

(b) The salary of each of the several judges of the Supreme Bench
