

SEC. 4. *And be it further enacted*, That the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be paid by the Treasurer of the State upon the warrant of the Comptroller out of the proceeds of the sale of said bonds or Certificates of Indebtedness for the payment of the expense of engraving, printing and other outlays connected with the issue of the loan hereby authorized, and for the payment of the advertising directed by this Act, and all other incidental expenses connected with the execution of its provisions in connection with said loan.

SEC. 5. *And be it further enacted*, That (A) The actual cash proceeds of the sale of the Certificates of Indebtedness to be issued under this Act shall be paid to the Treasurer of the State upon the warrant of the Comptroller and such proceeds shall be used exclusively for the following purposes, to wit:

(B) The Comptroller shall immediately upon the sale of and payment for said certificates, first, return to and credit the Treasury for a sum equivalent to the amount expended, as provided in Section 4 of this Act; the remainder of the proceeds of said loan shall be credited on the books of the State Treasury Department, to be expended as needed by the State, upon approval by the Board of Public Works, for the following needs, purposes and projects, and amounts listed below being intended to include Architects' and Engineers' fees where applicable:
