II. And be it enacted. That immediately after the passage of this act the fees CHAP. of the examiner on the eastern shore shall be and they are hereby increased thirty- Fees intiree and one third per cent. in addition to his fees already allowed by law.

III. This act to continue and be in force till the twentieth day of October, Duration. aighteen hundred, and till the end of the next session of assembly that shall hapben thereafter.

> C H A P. CVIII.

An ACT authorifing Henry Stevenson, collector of Baltimore Passed Januacounty, to complete his collections.

THEREAS Henry Stevenson, late collector of Baltimore county, hath Preamble. fet forth by his petition to this general affembly, that there is still due to him as collector a confiderable sum of money, which he has been unable to collect, and prays that a longer time may be allowed him to complete the collection of the same,

II. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the said Henry H. Stevenson Stevenson be and he is hereby authorised to collect all balances due him as col- to collect, &c. lector for the last year, at any time before the first day of October next, in the same manner as he could or might have done whilst he was collector, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.

III. Provided always, and be it enacted, That the said Henry Stevenson, Proviso. before he proceeds to execute or distrain the property of any person or persons for officers sees or taxes, shall, at least ten days before such execution or distress, deliver to the person chargeable with the same an account, written in words at full length, of the taxes demanded of him, her or them, with an affidavit annexed to the same, that he hath not, to the best of his knowledge, received any part thereof, nor any thing in fecurity or fatisfaction for the same, more than the credits given; and provided also, that the said Henry Stevenson, before he derives any benefit from or under this act, shall lodge his collector's books in the clerk's office of Baltimore county court, to be there open to the inspection of all persons interested in the same.

C H A P.

An additional supplement to the act, entitled, An act relating to Paffed Januapublic roads in this state, and to repeal the acts of assembly therein mentioned.

E it enacted, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That so much of the Part of an act seventh section of the said original act, passed at November session, seventeen repealed, &c. hundred and ninety-four, as directs the several supervisors to give bond, with such security as shall be approved by the said justices, be and hereby is repealed, so far as it concerns Baltimore county, and that instead thereof, every supervisor appointed in Baltimore county in virtue of the said act shall, within thirty days next after his appointment, give bond to the state of Maryland, with fuch fureties as shall be approved by the clerk of the said county, who is hereby directed and required to take the same, in double the sum that may be apportioned by the levy court to be expended or laid out by the faid supervisor; provided, that no security shall be approved as aforesaid by the clerk of the said county, unless it be established, to the satisfaction of such clerk, that each and every fuch furety be seized and possessed, in his own right, of a clear freehold estate of the value of double the sum of money that may be apportioned as aforefaid by the levy court of faid county to be expended by the faid supervisor.

II. And be it enacted, That from and after the first day of May next, one One fourth of fourth of the justices of Baltimore county shall be a sufficient number to constitute a quorum, to do and perform in faid county all matters and things which by the said original act, and supplements aforesaid, the justices, or a majority of them, were authorised and empowered to do and perform in said county.
