C H A P. LXXIII.

An ACT for building a new gaol in Baltimore county. HEREAS by the petition of fundry inhabitants of Baltimore county it is represented to this general assembly, that the public gaol of the faid county is in a ruinous state, and in every respect unfit for use,

and that a new gaol ought to be erected in faid county; therefore,

II. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Samuel Ow- Commissionings, James Carroll, John Merryman, James Carey and Nicholas Rogers, shall ers appointed, be commissioners for the purpose of erecting a new gaol in the said county of Baltimore, upon the public ground in the city of Baltimore appropriated by law for the gaol and court-house of said county; and the said commissioners, or a majority of them, are hereby empowered to contract for materials, and to agree with workmen, to build and finish the said gaol, which, when completed, shall by the said commissioners be put into the custody and possession of the sheriff of Baltimore county for the time being, and so shall remain and continue in the custody and possession of such sheriff, and his successors, as the public gaol of the faid county of Baltimore.

III. and he it enacted, That the levy court of Baltimore county be and they Money to be are hereby empowered and directed, to impose annually on the affessable property affessed, &c. of the faid county the fum of four thousand dollars current money, to be affessed, together with an allowance to the collector of the same commission for collection that he receives for collecting the other county levy, which fum, so affelfed, shall be collected by the collector of Baltimore county as other county taxes are collected, and when so collected shall, by the said collector, be paid to the commissioners aforesaid, to be applied by them, or a majority of them, towards erecting the said gaol; which said sum of sour thousand dollars current money shall be annually imposed by the said levy court on the assessable property of the faid county, to be affeffed, collected, paid and applied as aforefaid, until the requisite money be collected for the completing of the said gaol.

IV. and be it enacted, That the faid commissioners, or a majority of them, Materials shall be and they are hereby authorised to sell any of the materials of the old &c. gaol of said county, and the earth and sand of the said public ground, and to apply the money thence arising to defraying the expences of the new gaol.

V. And be it enacted, That in case any of the said commissioners shall refuse How vacanto act, shall refign, die, or remove out of the county, or be incapable to act, filled. the remaining commissioners, or the major part of them, shall fill up such vacancy.

VI. And he it enacted, That the faid commissioners, or a majority of them, Commissioners to borrow thall be and they are hereby empowered to borrow, from time to time, such sum money, &c. or sums of money as they may conceive to be necessary, at an interest not exceeding fix per centum per annum, which faid loan or loans shall be appropriated and applied by them to the erecting of the faid gaol; and to receive the repayment of the faid fum or fums of money, with the interest thereon, the faid commissioners shall be and they are hereby authorised to assign and transfer to the lender or lenders thereof any part or parts of the before-mentioned taxes, to be annually collected as aforesaid, which lender or lenders shall, in such case, have all the rights and privileges in enforcing the payment to them of the faid taxes that the commissioners should have had if such transfer had not been made.

VII. And be it enacted, That the commissioners aforesaid shall annually ren- Render an der to the levy court of Baltimore county a particular account of the receipts and account, &c. expenditures of all monies intrufted to them, and also the progress and state of the building.

VIII. and be it enacted, That the commissioners aforesaid, before they pro- And give bond, see. ceed to the execution of the trust herein committed to them, shall give bond to
