C H A P. LXXVII.

An ACT to regulate the time of holding the orphans courts in Paffed Janua-Dorchester county, and to repeal part of the act of assembly therein mentioned.

E it enacted, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That the orphans When courts courts in Dorchester county shall hereafter be held on the second Tuesdays are to be held. in June, August, October, December, February and April, yearly, or oftener, if need be, by adjournment:

II. And be it enacted, That the third section of the act passed at February Part of an act fession, one thousand seven hundred and eighty-six, entitled, An act to revive and repealed. continue the proceedings of the orphans court of Dorchester county, be and the fame is hereby repealed.

C H A P. LXXVIII.

An ACT to empower the veftry of Shrewsbury parish, in Kent Passed Januacounty, to fell the glebe-land belonging to the same.

THEREAS the vestry of Shrewsbury parish, of Kent county, have Preamble. petitioned this general affembly for a law empowering them to fell the glebe-land belonging to faid parish, for the purpose of purchasing other land in a more convenient and advantageous situation, and also to enable faid vestry to repair the church and chapel in said parish, which are in a ruinous condition; and have represented to this general assembly, that the said vestry possess no funds to defray the expence of repairing said church and chapel; there-

II. Be it enafted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the vestry of Vestry may faid parish be and they are hereby empowered to sell said glebe-land, and to apply fuch part of the money arising from the sale thereof as they deem proper to the purchase of other land for the use of said parish, and the surplus to the reparation of faid church and chapel; provided nevertheless, that the faid vestry give three months previous notice, by advertisements stuck up at the courthouse door for said county, and one at each door of the church and chapel respectively, of the time and place of sale.

C H A P. LXXIX.

An ACT to make a temporary allowance to the judges of the Passed Januacourt of appeals, in addition to their permanent salaries.

E it enafted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That each of the judges Additional of the court of appeais shall be entitled to receive three hundred dollars, in addition to their permanent salaries fixed by law.

II. And be it enacted, That the faid sums shall be paid at the same time, and When to be in the same manner, during the continuance of this act, as their permanent salaries are by law directed to be paid.

III. This act to continue and be in force until the twentieth day of October, Duration. eighteen hundred, and until the end of the next session of assembly that shall happen thereafter.
