figns for ever, all right, title, interest and claim, if any, that the state hath or CHAP. may have in and to all that tract of land called Sandy Wharf, lying in Worcefter county.

C H A P. XI.

An ACT to prevent the going at large of swine within five miles Passed Januaof the city of Baltimore, in Baltimore county.

E it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That from and after No swine to the first day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety-eight, no fwine shall be suffered to go at large within five miles of the city of Baltimore, and if any person shall find on his land, or on any land in his possession, lying within five miles of the said city, any swine, it shall and may be lawful for him any such swine to kill or impound, or cause to

be killed or impounded.

II. And he it enacted, That if any person shall be sued for killing or im-Persons shed pounding any swine found upon his land, or on any land in his possession, the dec. defendant may plead the general iffue, and give this act and the special matter in evidence; provided, that nothing in this act shall be construed to extend to or prevent any swine going at large in Anne-Arundel county.

C H A P. XII.

An ACT to empower the levy court of Harford county to affels Paffed Januaand levy a sum of money for the purpose therein mentioned.

THEREAS Thomas Shewell, of Harford county, by his petition to Preamble. this general affembly hath set forth, that he is an extreme poor man, and that he hath a fon, who has for a confiderable time been afflicted with lunacy, and is unable to support his family with the incumbrance of said lunatic, and praying that a law may pass to provide for the support of his said fon out of the poor-house; and the prayer of said petition appearing reasonable. therefore,

II. Be it enafted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the justices suffices to less of Harford county shall be and they are hereby directed and empowered, at their vy money, levy courts annually, as long as they may see cause, to assess and levy on said county a fum of money, not exceeding forty dollars, for the support and maintenance of the faid son of the faid Thomas Shewell aforesaid, and that the same be collected and paid annually to the aforesaid Thomas Shewell by the collector or collectors of Harford county, agreeable to the order of the levy court aforesaid.

CHAP. XIII.

An ACT to authorife and empower the levy court of Saint-Mary's Paffed Januar county to affels and levy annually a fum of money for the fupport of Elizabeth Goodrick.

THEREAS Mary Goodrick, of Saint-Mary's county, by her petition Preamble. to this general affembly hath fet forth, that she is a very poor widow, and hath the misfortune to have one of her six children, named Elizabeth Goodrick, born an idiot; that she, the said idiot, is seventeen years old, incapable of doing any kind of labour, and requires one person constantly to attend her, and praying a law may pass authorising and empowering the levy court of Saint-Mary's county to affels and levy annually a fum of money for the

support of her said daughter; and the sacts appearing to be true,

II. Be it enafted, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That the justices of Justices to le the peace of Saint-Mary's county, at their levy court, shall have full power and vy money, authority, and they are hereby directed and required, annually to affels, (so long as they shall see cause,) on the affestable property of said county, a sum not exceeding forty dollars for any one year, which said sum, so levied and affessed, shall be collected as other county charges are, and paid to the said Mary Good-
