

sub-title "Chapter 27. Free Scholarships", to follow immediately after Section 284 thereof, and to read as follows:

284A.

The Attorney General shall compile and periodically review the surety bonds given by persons accepting scholarships in education under any of the provisions of this sub-title or elsewhere in this Article, giving security that such persons will teach in the public schools of this State for not less than two years (or any other SPECIFIED period) after leaving the institution. Upon the failure or refusal of any such person to observe the conditions of the bond, by teaching for a less period than stipulated or for no period at all, the Attorney General shall do such things as are necessary and proper to enforce the obligation of the bond.

NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS SUB-TITLE OR ELSEWHERE IN THIS ARTICLE, WHENEVER THERE IS A REQUIREMENT IN ANY PROVISION OF THIS SUB-TITLE OR ELSEWHERE IN THIS ARTICLE THAT AN APPLICANT AWARDED A SCHOLARSHIP SHALL GIVE A BOND TO TEACH IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF THIS STATE FOR A SPECIFIED TIME, ALL BONDS REQUIRED OF SUCH SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS OR APPOINTEES, HEREAFTER GIVEN, SHALL CONTAIN A PROVISION OR CONDITION TO THE EFFECT THAT WITHIN FIVE YEARS AFTER LEAVING THE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION TO WHICH THE APPOINTEE IS AWARDED A SCHOLARSHIP, EXCLUDING A MAXIMUM OF FOUR YEARS IN MILITARY SERVICE, HE OR SHE WILL TEACH IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF THIS STATE FOR NOT LESS THAN TWO YEARS.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1961.
