tion or corporation, or for any agency, member or representative thereof, directly or indirectly, to solicit money, donations of money, property or financial assistance of any kind, to sell or offer to sell any article, tag, service, emblem, publication, ticket, advertisement, subscription, or anything of value, on the plea or the representation that such sale or solicitation, or the proceeds thereof, is for a charitable, patriotic or philanthropic purpose, in Washington County unless such person, organization, society, association or corporation shall have first obtained a permit as provided for in this ordinance.

148B.

Such application shall be sworn to and filed in duplicate with the Clerk to the County Commissioners, who shall forthwith transmit a copy of the same to the County Commissioners and shall make an investigation of such application, and shall submit his report to the County Commissioners within thirty days after the date said application is filed with him, which shall either approve or reject such application. Said application shall contain the following information, or in lieu thereof, a detailed statement of the reason, or reasons why such information cannot be furnished.

- (a) The name of the organization applying for the permit, and the address of its headquarters.
- (b) The names and addresses of its principal officers and management.
- (e) The purpose for which such solicitation is to be made and the use or disposition to be made of any receipts therefrom.
- (d) The names of the person or persons, by whom the receipts of such solicitation shall be disbursed.
- (e) The name of the persons comprising the local board of directors or committee which will be in direct charge of conducting the solicitation.
- (f) An outline of the method, or methods, to be used in conducting the solicitations.
- (g) The time when such solicitations shall be made, giving the preferred dates for the beginning and ending of such solicitation.
- (h) The amounts of any wages, fees, commissions, expenses or emoluments to be extended or paid to anyone in connection with such solicitation, together with the manner in which such wages, fees, expenses, commissions, or emoluments are to be expended, to whom paid, and the amount thereof.
- (i) A financial statement or audit prepared by a certified public accountant for the last preceding purposes set out in Section 148A hereof, by the organization or persons seeking a permit for such solicitations; said statement giving the amount of money so raised, together with the cost of raising it, and final distribution thereof.
- (j) A full statement of the character and extent of the charitable, patriotic or philanthropic work being done by the applicant organization within Washington County.
- (k) A statement that actual cost of the solicitation will not exceed ten per cent of the total amount to be raised.
