(1) A statement to the effect that if a permit is granted, it will not be used or represented in any way as an endorsement by Washington County or any department or officer thereof.

## 148C.

- (a) In addition to the requirements imposed under Section 148B above, every applicant shall prove to the satisfaction of the County Commissioners and the County Commissioners shall require that:
- (b) No remuneration of any kind shall be paid to any soliciting personnel of the applicant.
- (c) The officers and administering personnel of the applicant shall be adequately covered by a fidelity bond.
- (d) If the solicitation is for a newly organized local project of a special welfare nature, that it has the approval of the Community Services Council; and if a nation-wide solicitation for a welfare purpose that the budget of the solicitating group has the approval of the National Budget Committee of the National Social Welfare Assembly, and if a nation wide solicitation that the local chapter or branch has the discretion, within the purposes of the solicitation, to distribute funds in its custody for local purposes.
- (e) The solicitation by the applicant is for a worthy cause and a reasonably urgent need exists for the cause, that the cause is one that will not duplicate the work of any existing governmental or nongovernmental agency or organization, and that the solicitation is of such a nature that it cannot be made through or served with the annual United Fund Campaign.
- (f) The applicant proposes to solicit an aggregate amount in Washington County consistent with the type and volume of services rendered in the County, and definite assurance is given that the aid or assistance solicited shall be transmitted to the beneficiary for whom the funds are being solicited.
- (g) Any applicant will conduct its solicitation at a time not in conflict with any other existing solicitations, in order to prevent undue hardship on the ability of the citizens of the county to engaging in or contributing to such solicitations.

## 148D.

Upon determination by the County Commissioners, either that said permit should be granted, or rejected, it shall endorse its action thereon, and file the same with the Clerk.

In the event of rejection of said permit, the applicant shall be given notice of the action of the County Commissioners.

## 148E.

Upon the granting of a permit as provided for in this ordinance, a duplicate thereof shall be furnished the Sheriff of Washington County.

## 148F.

Whenever it shall be shown, or whenever the Clerk has knowledge that any person, organization, society, association, or corporation to
