section to authorize any persons, political subdivisions and officers, public or private, to use any funds owned or controlled by them for the purchase of any such bonds or other obligations. Nothing contained in this section with regard to legal investments shall be construed as relieving any person of any duty of exercising reasonable care in selecting securities.

Sub-Section 11. Separability

If any provision of this Article, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances, is held invalid, the remainder of the Article and the application of such provision to persons or circumstances other than those as to which it is held invalid, shall not be affected thereby. The powers conferred by this Article shall be in addition and supplemental to the powers conferred by any other law.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1961.

CHAPTER 845

(House Bill 853)

AN ACT to add new Section 16-46 to the Code of Public Local Laws of Anne Arundel County (1957 Edition, being Article 2 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Anne Arundel County", sub-title "Police", to follow immediately after Section 16-45 thereof, providing for school crossing guards in Anne Arundel County under the control and supervision of the Board of Police Examiners, specifying the duties of the school crossing guards, providing a penalty for persons not obeying the orders of such guards and relating generally to the establishment and control of a corps of school crossing guards in Anne Arundel County.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That new Section 16-46 be and it is hereby added to the Code of Public Local Laws of Anne Arundel County (1957 Edition, being Article 2 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Anne Arundel County", sub-title "Police", to follow immediately after Section 16-45 thereof, and to read as follows:

- 16-46. (a) The Board of Police Examiners is hereby authorized and empowered to appoint, train, uniform and equip such school crossing guards as they may deem necessary for the safety of children at school crossings.
- (b) The school crossing guards shall be subject to all rules and regulations as now or hereafter adopted by the Board of Police Examiners of Anne Arundel County. However, such school crossing
