"Schools", to repeal an obsolete local law relating to the establishment and supervision of McDonogh Institute, the Manual Training School for the county.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 253 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Charles County (1959 Edition, being Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Charles County", sub-title "Schools", be and it is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1961.

## CHAPTER 868

## (House Bill 758)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 261 and 263 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Charles County (1959 Edition, being Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Charles County", subtitle "Sheriff", to repeal obsolete local laws in Charles County relating to certain fees and sums allowed to the Sheriff of the county.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 261 and 263 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Charles County (1959 Edition, being Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Charles County", sub-title "Sheriff", be and it is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1961.

## CHAPTER 869

## (House Bill 760)
