SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1961.

#### CHAPTER 868

(House Bill 758)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 261 and 263 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Charles County (1959 Edition, being Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Charles County", sub-title "Sheriff", to repeal obsolete local laws in Charles County relating to certain fees and sums allowed to the Sheriff of the county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sections 261 and 263 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Charles County (1959 Edition, being Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Charles County", sub-title "Sheriff", be and it is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1961.

#### CHAPTER 869

(House Bill 760)
