

Charles County (1959 Edition, being Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Charles County", sub-title "Orphans' Court", to repeal an obsolete local law of Charles County specifying the compensation of judges of the Orphans' Court of the county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 222 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Charles County (1959 Edition being Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Charles County", sub-title "Orphans' Court", be and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1961.

CHAPTER 872

(House Bill 763)

AN ACT to repeal Section 238 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Charles County (1959 Edition, being Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Charles County", sub-title "Register of Wills", and to repeal the sub-title "Register of Wills", to repeal an obsolete local law of Charles County requiring the register of wills to keep an index of wills and other testamentary law matters.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 238 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Charles County (1959 Edition, being Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Charles County", sub-title "Register of Wills", be and the same is hereby repealed, and that the sub-title "Register of Wills" be and it is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1961.

CHAPTER 873

(House Bill 796)

AN ACT to add new Section 73A to the Code of Public Local Laws of Charles County (1959 Edition, being Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Charles County", sub-title "County Commissioners" to follow immediately after Section 73 thereof and to be under the new sub-heading "Charles County Code Supplement", to authorize the County Commissioners of Charles County to prepare and publish biennially a supplement to
